

## **Troubleshooting: How to Group Objects**


\*\*\*These instructions are designed for PC Users PowerPoint 2013 version 18. If you are using a different version it may look slightly different. \*\*\*

1. Select one of your images or shapes. Hold down the "shift" key and select the other shapes in your slide.







2. Let go of the "Shift" key and click "Arrange" at the top of your screen.



3. From the drop-down menu click "Group."
